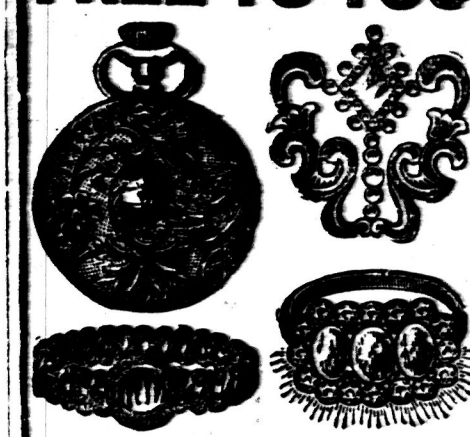

Chicago Board of Trade Explain Use of Chicago

Chicago is the best description of the purpose of the Chicago Board of Trade was given by Secretary George F. Stone before a committee of the United States senate. Mr. Stone's statements were made in answer to questions, but they cover the ground fully and may be summarized as follows:

The primary function of boards of trade is to bring the buyers and sellers together in the interest of fairness and equity and to facilitate the marketing of products and merchandise and to provide the means for their distribution to the consumers in different sections of the country and in different parts of the world.

The first steps taken towards the organization of the Chicago Board of Trade were taken in 1848, on the 12th of March of that year. The first annual meeting was in 1849.

The principal advantages presented to the membership of the board are: 1. The membership of the board is composed of the most prominent business men of the city, and the board is organized to represent the interests of the city and the country.
