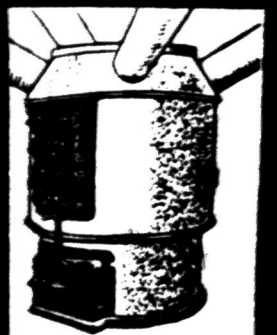

The Dog Tax.

The Municipal World is supposed to be an authority on all questions arising from municipal councils and in reply to a recent query on the subject of dog by-laws they have answered as follows: The council has no authority to pass a by-law imposing a tax on dogs. The act passed last session of the Legislative imposes the tax mentioned therein on dogs in every municipality, and it is the duty of the council to collect it. And by-laws that that have hitherto been passed by councils under the authority of sub-section 3, of section 540 of the Consolidated Municipal Act, 1903, and which were in force when the repealing section was passed can, of course, now have no force or effect, as their provisions as taxing dogs have been superseded by those of the statute.

TOO HOT TO WORK.

Some of the old members of cow testing associations appreciate the system very much, and are realizing a profit by it. In the Shearer, Ont. association, for instance, one man states that he has delivered to the factory almost as much milk from ten cows as he did two years ago from fourteen cows. He has sold one of the ten for \$45.00 for beef. At her best she gave 31 lbs. of milk per day: she is replaced by a cow costing \$50.00, now giving 41 lbs. of milk per day.

This statement shows the immense saving of labour that can be effected by keeping cows selected on their records. It is too hot weather to work round and bother with four unnecessary cows if the smaller herd, as indicated above, brings as good a return. If it pays to milk a cow it pays to milk a good one. The herd needs pruning of the dead, unprofitable wood. Dairy records of individual cows show conclusively which to lop off. Blank forms are supplied free of charge on application to the Dairy Commissioner, Ottawa.

W. H. Willson Shot.

Welland, July 17. — Last night Mr. W. H. Willson, manager of Hennessy's drug store, was accidentally shot and killed by a revolver in the hands of George Laing, night policeman. Laing's revolver was not working well, and he borrowed, a few days ago, a revolver from Willson and cleaned his own. Last night he returned Willson's, and was showing him how well the revolver he had cleaned worked. Supposing he had removed all the cartridges he snapped the revolver. Willson, who was sitting in a chair, received the ball in his heart. Dr. Colbeck and Dr. McClelland were summoned immediately, but the injured man expired in a few minutes.

The accident occurred at the police office, where Willson had called to get his revolver. No one else was present at the time. Willson was aged thirty, and leaves a widow and two small children residing in Hamilton, he being part of the time engaged in Hennessy's drug store in Hamilton. He was an exemplary young man and highly respected.

Laing is a careful, steady man, and is beside himself with grief.

For His Sick Mother.

Windsor, July 17. — Norman Bradt, an employee of a local bakery here, was arrested yesterday, charged with having failed to account for some \$62 which he collected for the firm. Bradt's plea was that he had used the money to provide the necessities of life for his aged mother, who is seriously ill. After hearing the story and ascertaining that Bradt previous record was good, the prisoner was released on \$1,000 bail, to appear for a further hearing next Thursday.
