Gas from under Lake.

(From the Toronto Telegram)

Selkirk, Ont., Feb. 25.—It is not generally known that natural gas is now being drawn in paying quantities out of Lake Erie. Not exactly from the lake itself, but from the rocky bottom of it. The efforts of a company which secured its rights from the Government, having conceived the idea that as all the land around here bordering the lake is gas producing it was quite likely that that under the lake was of similar quality, have been crowned with success.

Several fine wells are now producing gas from under the lake, about a mile from the shore. The boring of these wells was done from a scow and when gas in sufficient quantities was found it was piped to land. Some of it goes to Brantford, some to Galt, Hamilton, St. Catharines and other cities. One day it is expected there will be gas piped from this district clear to Toronto. There does not seem to be any limit to the supply of natural gas in Rainham and Waipole townships. Just about every farm has its gas well and some of them more than one. Gas here is only 15 cents a thousand feet, yet those fortunate enough to own a supply are getting rich selling it. A good many farmers have piped their own wells and enjoy freely the great boon nature and their peculiar situation gives them. They don't do much regular farming hereabouts. It is mostly natural gas farming.

Property has taken a wonderful jump of late. There is the case of one man who bought an acre of land for a sawmill for \$500. He struck gas and recently he was offered \$15,000 for the bit of land.

All the gas lands have been taken up—that's why they went out into the lake looking for it. Where the wells are sunk the water is only six or seven feet deep, for Lake Erie is very shallow at this shore. This is one of the things which would prevent the newer Welland Canal coming through here.

Rush of Immigration.

Halifax, March 6.—Seven steamers, with a combined tonnage of nearly 35,000 tons, entered the port of Halifax between Saturday morning and Sunday. The largest were the Allan liners Corsican and Hesperian of eleven and ten thousand tons respectively. The four thousand ton Italian steamer Campania came next, and then followed the Mexican liner Bornu of two thousand tons, the freighter Strathraig of 1,300 tons, and the collier Morien.

Over one thousand new settlers entered Canada through Halifax on Saturday, and by the time the last immigrant had been despatched to the west and arrangements made for caring for those detained the immigration and railway ticketing staffs at deep water were well tired out. The rush began on Saturday, when the Allan liner Hesperian, with one thousand persons, tied up at pier No. 2. All her passengers were landed for examination, and about 700 of them left the ship here. Two special trains left about midnight, one with C. P. R. passengers and the other with I. C. R. and G. T. R. passengers. Then the liner Campania was lying at anchor out

in the stream with 1,300 passengers, of whom nearly 500 were to be landed, and about 1 o'clock this afternoon her immigrants began to come ashore, and the rush of the previous day was on all over again. Two more special trains left again at midnight carrying the Campania's passengers.

To add to the bustle, the Allan Liner Corsican was in port for six or seven hours on Saturday, and took on a number of passengers for the other side, as well as mails. Twenty-nine persons were deported on her.
