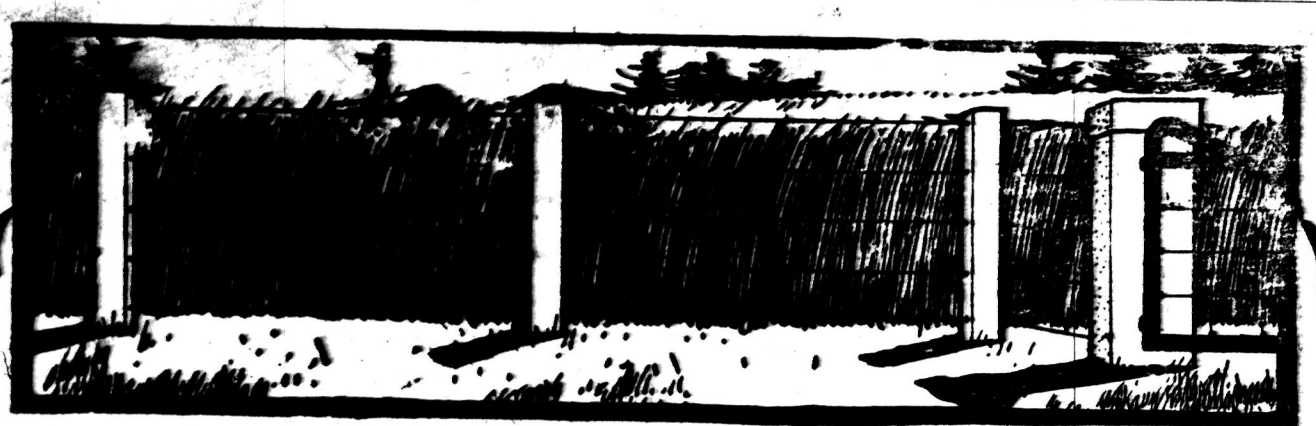

Canada  
It has been said that Canadians do not fully appreciate the country in which they live. One has only to study conditions as they exist in other lands to be convinced that in Canada we have one of the best countries on the face of the earth. There has never been a famine in Canada. Other lands have their hurricanes and tornadoes, their earthquakes and their volcanoes, which exact their tribute in life and property every few years. None of these have left their scars on the face of our broad land. Canada has no social or political problems that cannot be settled by the sober sense of her people. The anarchist finds here little scope for his nefarious practices. The causes which are the reason to be for his existence in other countries do not exist in Canada. Our summer and winter, our spring and fall are each and all delightful in themselves and furnish a variety of climate, which many other countries do not possess. To have summer all the year round is very nice to talk about, but it does not give that variety to the spice of living, which the human race seems to require to do its very best, and more often than not leads to mediocre conditions in the character and habits of the people. The change from fall to winter, from winter to spring, from spring to summer, and from summer to fall, makes life less a monotony.

### Water Purification.

The following is a simple method of water purification by G. G. Naamith, Ph. D., and R. R. Graham, M.B., Laboratory of the Provincial Board of Health. A level teaspoonful of chloride of lime should be rubbed into a teaspoon of water. The solution should be diluted with three cupfuls of water; and a teaspoonful of the whole quantity should be added to each two gallon pail of drinking water. This will give .4 or .5 parts of free chlorine to a million parts of water and will in ten minutes destroy all typhoid and colon bacilli or other dysentery producing organisms in the water. Moreover, all traces of the chlorine will rapidly disappear. This method of purification has been tested with Toronto Bay water inoculated with millions of bacteria. Every germ has been destroyed and it has been unnecessary to boil the water. This method should be very valuable for miners, prospectors, campers, and those living in summer resorts where the condition of the waters might not be above suspicion.
