lend Plan Proposed to Build Skyteropers with Rapid Pire Gues Which will Pire Coment and Sund «Stick Books the Resper this Summer-Herr Rievators to Bouse Repeated Barrest.

(From our own Correspondent)

Montreal, June 12.—While skyscraper have shot up here in the past to such an extent that an eight-storey building has been erected in 48 working days, they will instead of shooting up be shot up in the future, if a recent invention makes good. This does not mean, however, that wild west schemes will be enacted in the tall buildings here but merely that a new rapid fire method of construction has appeared which may smash all building records existing at present. So great is the demand for quick work that it is actually proposed to shoot walls into place with a rapid fire gun. The present cement mixer, it is claimed, is to give way to the cement gun which will shoot liquid cement into place by means of compressed 'air twenty-four times as rapidly as is possible under the present system. The gun itself consists of a long tube of great strength. Into this is admitted compressed air through a valve near the breech, and water through another valve near the muzzle. Atabout the point of the vent in the ordinary breehloading cannon, a tube like connection is established with a hopper. Dry cement and sand are thrown into this hopper by two men, and here, aside from valve manipulation and directing the cement stream, the human element ends. The hopper vibrates, mixing the contents before it drops down through the tube connection. Once in the gun barrel the mixture is shot forward by the compressed air fed through the valve. At the muzzle a stream of water is encountered that mixes with the sand and cement. the whole driving out the gun with sufficient force to carry it to the desired point. As a result of this rapid fire method of construction building records never before dreamed of may soon be established here.

An analysis made by the Civic Health Department shows that infantile mortality in the city stands about the same rate as last year, while the birth rate is on the increase.
