LOCAL PREACHERS.—Bro. James Garlow is developing into a very useful helper while Bro. Hiram Copeland is winning for himself a place in the hearts of the people. We have been intensely busy throughout the year. We have tried to visit the people in their homes as often as possible, and with very few exceptions have received a warm welcome. The increase of 27 members to the church has been largely brought about by visiting. The sick have taken a great deal of our time and strength and we believe that we have won some for the kingdom in this way. In the sick room the Blessor has sometimes seemed so near. We have set up with the mourners around the dead; in the home of bereavement reading the blessed word and exhorting the living to better things. We have put our hand to the cross-cut saw, or to the axe in helping get fuel for those in distress. In home and church 41 little ones have been given to the Lord in baptism. Many of these services have been a real means of grace. We have had a few good cottage prayer meetings. Health has been generally given us to preach three times every Sunday, save four when duty has called us elsewhere. Brethren it has been to us a good year—a blessed year. We have almost forgotten its dark days, its storms, its seeming unsurmountable barriers, and its daily round of common place things which have so often wearied us. Some have failed in whom we had such hope. Others have come almost unto the kingdom but to go back to live a life of greater carelessness. In looking back our disappointments have been his appointments. Why I heard a voice just the last Sunday in the testimony meeting speak for Jesus, that was silent a year ago—a life transformed. On yonder sick bed is a man whose heart a year ago seemed as hard as stone, now he loves Missionary work and is rising from prayer we have seen the tears stealing their way down his cheeks. He is getting ready for the home amid the saints. Hallelulah.

In closing we only pray that our mistakes and shortcomings may be overlooked for the glory of God for at best our service has been one of weakness—a faltering blundering service—with a wider vision of our world's task at times almost forgotten amid the many seeming trivial duties on a mission station.
