Color of Lightning.

The color of lightning is almost entirely due to the nature of the substance in its track that is made incandescent. The blue, red, purple or silver tints, which are ordinarily much more brilliantly marked tropical countries than they ever are in this latitude, are due to the same circumstance as those which produce the color designedly communicated to the light of different kinds of fireworks. Each different foreign ingredient that floats in the air has its own proper hue, which it can communicate to the lightning. The vapor of iron has one kind of shine and the vapor of sulphur another.

Hardwoods

Canada is dependent for its lumber supply on the soft woods of the forest, much more than in the United States, as seen from the 1910 Forest Products report compiled by the Dominion Forestry Branch and shortly to be published. Of the 1910 Canadian lumber cut amounting to nearly five billion feet, only one-twentieth consisted of hardwoods or hard-leaved trees, worth barely \$5,000,000; on the other hand almost one quarter of the lumber cut in the United States consists of hardwoods, which country has far greater hardwood forests than ever did Canada.

Canada is already feeling a shortage of the hardwood supply and makes up the national deficiency by importing annually from the United States, hardwood lumber to the value of seven and a half million dollars. Thus the value of the hardwoods imported into Canada during 1910 exceeded by 50% the value of the hardwoods manufactured into lumber. Nearly all of these imports are from the United States and consist of the most valuable species such as oak, hickory, tulip or yellow poplar, chestnut, gum, walnut, cherry and a large amount of hard pine which is so frequently used as a hardwood. From these above figures it is seen that we are becoming more and more dependent upon the United States whose available supply for export is surely and rapidly decreasing. Whatever can be done to improve the resources of Canada by the elimination of wood waste, and particularly by the development of the small wood lots of Ontario, Southern Quebec and the Maritime provinces, should be done will all possible speed.

Change in the Seed Control Act.

During the recent session of Parliament important changes were made in the Seed Control Act, respecting the sale of clover and timothy seed. Under the old Act the inspector sometimes found it difficult to prove violations though misrepresentations were being made. A dealer might offer red clover seed, containing as many as 92 noxious weed seeds per ounce and an unlimited number of other weed seeds such as Foxtail, represent it as his best grade and charge nearly as much as his competitor asked for No. 1. He would not mark it No. 1 but he might state verbally that it was No. 1 or just as good. This has often been done, with the result that farmers as well as retail merchants who really wanted to buy pure seed have been contaminated seed and paid high prices for it. Under the new Act such misrepresentations will be impossible and both farmers and retail merchants will be able to buy their seed more intelligently. Four grades are fixed by the Act for red clover, alfalfa, timothy and timothy seed and all seed sold for seeding purposes by seedsmen must be plainly labelled with the grade. Any seed not grading No. 3, which is a higher standard than the old prohibitive line of five noxious weed seeds per thousand of good seed, is prohibited from sale. The following are the standards for freedom from weed seeds:

Red Clover, Alfalfa, Timothy	All weed seeds per oz.
No. 1, 5	100
No. 2, 20	200
No. 3, 80	400
Alsike	All weed seeds per oz.
No. 1, 10	100
No. 2, 40	200
No. 3, 160	400

In addition to the standards for freedom from weed seeds, standards for purity in other respects and general appearance are fixed for Extra No. 1, No. 1 and No. 2. Double the number of noxious weed seeds are allowed in alsike on account of the greater difficulty in cleaning this seed. Farmers and seed dealers should have their seed tested and graded before offering it for sale. Samples will be carried free through the mails and tested without charge if addressed to the Seeds Commissioner, Department of Agriculture Ottawa.

Western News Notes

Winnipeg, Man., Sept. 25th, 1911.—All indications point to the heaviest fall trade this city has ever known. With the utmost allowance made for damage to the crop by cold, wet weather such as the west has not known in many years, the production of Western Canada farms will still be stupendous. As a matter of fact, the weather has been cold in falling rather than in low temperature. There has been some frost in places, but none of a severe nature in any case. There has been more rain than common, but here, too, the weather is no accustomed to clear, bright days that anything other than brilliant sunshine is very bad in his sight.

The lowest estimate of the wheat crop places it at 177,400,000 bushels, with 192,250,000 bushels of oats, 34,313,000 bushels of barley, and 7,465,000 bushels of flax. Comparison of acreage under crop show that where there were 5,911,500 acres in '06 there were 14,041,187 acres in '10 and 16,062,710 this year. Excellent weather for plowing and the splendid crop has caused much new breaking, and it will not be surprising if the spring of 1912 sees near 20,000,000 acres under crop in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta.

All of this has brought a volume of business never before approached in the West. The case of Winnipeg is a fair example—enlarged beyond the ordinary of course—of business conditions in the west. There has not been a dull month, or even a dull week, since the opening of the year. At that time it was prophesied that Winnipeg bank clearings would go to the billion dollar mark this year. Eight months' figures show that January optimism has been justified by subsequent occurrences. The bank clearings for eight months and a week, amount to \$680,474,834, or well over the two-thirds of a billion dollars required to make the going for an even billion on December 31st.

Winnipeg building records, too, are climbing to new heights. Eight months' permits show a total of \$13,261,650, or within two million dollars of last year's total. The fall months are always extra busy with the builders, and it is not likely that this year's figures will stop short of 17,000,000.

There have been important industrial developments in Winnipeg of late. The new municipal power plant is nearly ready for service, and the prospect of cheap power in practically unlimited quantity is clearly an attractive proposition to manufacturers who see the desirability of getting near to the great market of the west. One of the largest of the new industries that have made definite choice of Winnipeg as a western location is the Anthes Foundry Co., Ltd. This company has begun operations for building a \$150,000 plant in Winnipeg, to employ a hundred hands at the state and to develop into a duplicate of the company's Toronto works. To this end the Anthes Company has secured a site of four acres, centrally located, and will begin the erection of the buildings at once. They will make soil pipe and sanitary supplies.

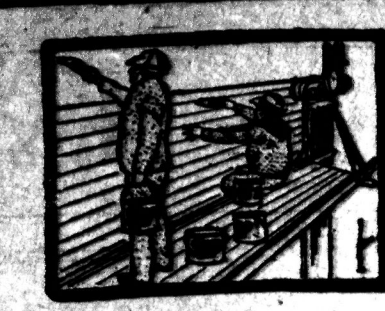
Another big firm to locate in Winnipeg is T. Mueller Manufacturing Co., of Decatur, Illinois. The Industrial Bureau reports that negotiations are practically completed for the establishment of a Winnipeg plant by this company. The T. Mueller Company makes brass goods and plumbers' supplies, and the west is a particularly rich field for operating such an enterprise. At the main plant the T. Mueller people employ 900 hands. Winnipeg has been favored of late with visits by many big men. Among these were Sir Thomas Shaughnessy, the Duke of Sutherland, Sir Charles Bessford and Lord Desborough. The latter addressed the Winnipeg Canadian Club, and laid down the principle of solidarity in the Empire through trade conferences and athletics. His address did not, however, lean strongly to athletics in spite of his predilection that way, but gave the club members an excellent talk on trade relations between the several parts of the Empire. The annual flower show of the Manitoba Provincial Horticultural Association was held two weeks ago, and made an excellent display of flowers, fruit and vegetables. The vegetable show was especially fine, and Manitoba apples, plums and grapes of excellent quality were features of the show.

A party of ten British editors of magazines and newspapers passed through Winnipeg recently. They were entertained by the city and the Industrial Bureau and spent a day at the Point Du Bois power plant. Lieut. Governor D. C. Cameron presided at the dinner given to the party at the Manitoba Club. The party was in charge of J. Obed Smith, formerly immigration commissioner here, and now stationed at London.
