What Haldimand Needs

The big deputation which waited on the Dominion Government last week to ask for a substantial aid for the construction of goods roads included, as representatives of Haldimand County (Cons.), Govee Pyle of Dunville, Reeve Parsons of Walpole, and Deputy Reeve Roulston of Walpole, the latter being a captain in the 37th Regiment, Haldimand Rifles. While at the capital they took advantage of the opportunity to wait on Hon. Sam Hughes, the Minister of Militia, and place before him the needs of the county in the matter of rifle ranges and armories. The deputation, which was introduced by Mr. F. R. Lator, M. P., pointed out to the Minister that one of the chief reasons why it had been found so difficult to get young men to take an interest in the regiment was because no proper facilities for rifle practice were provided, nor was there any suitable accommodation for the various

The Minister gave the arguments of the deputation a very sympathetic hearing, and they have reason to hope that an appropriation for the purposes mentioned may be made at an early date. In the same connection it may be noted that Mr. Lator has been pressing the claims of Dunville to have a suitable Government building erected. No doubt the claims of Caledonia were also noted. The town has long sought to have proper post office accommodation, and it is now or never. The supplementary estimates will soon be brought down in the House, and many anxious hours will be spent by the electors in this end of the county until the result is known. Our present position is only too well known—our thoughts are of the future. The influence of our present member should bear fruit and give Caledonia what it justly requires—a new and up-to-date post office.
