A canvass of opinions among the dealers revealed that the average size of shoes that women wear to-day is from four to five, whereas twenty years ago the average was from three to five. The No. 2 size in women's shoes has practically disappeared. Only one in twenty dealers handle terest either on the straight loan or on firms are sending their products out with a code number in place of the actual size number. Women refuse companies, and will take risks at the lowto wear the number that fitted them.
