How To Care For The Separator

While great care should be taken in running the cream separator at all times, it requires still greater attention in winter than in summer. Some interesting pointers on the winter care of the machine are given as follows by M. G. in Breeder's Gazette:

The oil supply is the first thing that should be given special attention. As the weather grows colder, the oil thickens. Either the oil feed should be so adjusted to keep those parts which run at such a high rate of speed from breaking, heating and cutting out, or else the oil should be thoroughly warmed to admit a free flow. Of the two we prefer the latter, but we practice both. This requires a little more oil, but oil is so cheap and separators are so high priced that we consider it economy to use the extra oil. We believe this very item is the main cause for so many cream separators wearing out in the course of a few years. The machines are started up while cold, the oil flows slowly to encourage a free motion, and the fine working parts of the machine thus are strained, worn and damaged. Then the additional hard labour and the loss of cream caused by the uneven and difficult running of the machine are other items that make this a most detrimental practice.

Most cream separators are operated where their parts become ice-cold between milkings during the extremely cold weather, so that any liquid, such as water, oil or milk, that comes in contact with them is quickly congealed and adheres to them. For this reason we pour hot water through the whole machine before using it, which loosens and warms every piece and part, allowing the free passage of oil and an easy movement of the mechanism. The oil we warm, and by these two influences the machine is kept well oiled and easy to operate. Once a week, or as often as occasion demands we run a generous amount of kerosene through parts of the separator to cut all gum, dust and other foreign substances from the shafts and gears. This also contributes to the ease of operation and reduces the wear and tear of the machine. The skimming device will also require careful attention at this season. All tinware and the bowl should be scalded out immediately after each skimming, as the temperature will cause any film to adhere quickly to these parts, so that it is liable to be overlooked. We run a quart of hot water through the bowl just before separating. This warms it and prevents the milk from adhering to it as it would if left cold until the milk had passed through it to warm it causing a loss of cream. With the bowl thoroughly warmed before separating, the milk passes through readily and skimming is begun at once.


Polishing Furniture

It is the duty of the prudent housewife to be as wary as possible in doctoring her furniture with polish. The highly polished surfaces have often been ruined by a too free use of a so-called polish. Not having been rubbed dry, it all too frequently hardens and collects the dust before drying, thus causing a dust film to appear over the polished surfaces. A simple and effective polish for cleansing furniture and removing scratches is made of one third linseed oil and two thirds benzine. It should be applied with a paint brush which has very soft bristles and then rubbed thoroughly dry with an old soft piece of muslin or flannel. For polishing, dampen a cloth with the mixture, fold it into a pad over the surface of which is sprinkled a few drops of alcohol and rub the furniture firmly and quickly. Rub only a small part at a time until the surface is quite dry.
