Hotelmen To Draft Their Indian List

Geoff, July 22.—In future habitual drunkards will not be served with liquor in any of the hotel bars or liquor stores of the city. It was so decided at a meeting of the hotelkeepers, and it is understood that it is their intention to draft a list of those known to be habitual drunkards, every hotelkeeper being supplied with a copy. Bartenders will also be given a copy, and ordered to refuse to serve anyone on the list with liquor. The list will start off with twenty-five names, and a number more will be added if thought advisable. This is the first move of the kind made by hotelkeepers in Canada. There are many unfortunately addicted to the use of liquor whose relatives cannot be induced to place them on the Indian list and it is thought that this move will be the means of keeping these men in a state of sobriety.

Killed Like His Pal Walking On The Track

St. Thomas, July 27.—John Conely, a one armed pencil vendor, known thru Western Ontario as "Red the Bum," was instantly killed while walking on the M. C. E. tracks between Cornwall and Tilsonburg yesterday morning. He stepped out of the way of a freight train and was struck by a light engine on the opposite track. "Red" was sixty years of age. His pal of years, Wm. Kennedy, "Bill the Bum," was killed while walking on the M. C. E. Tracks near Fletcher seven or eight years ago.—Tilsonburg Observer.

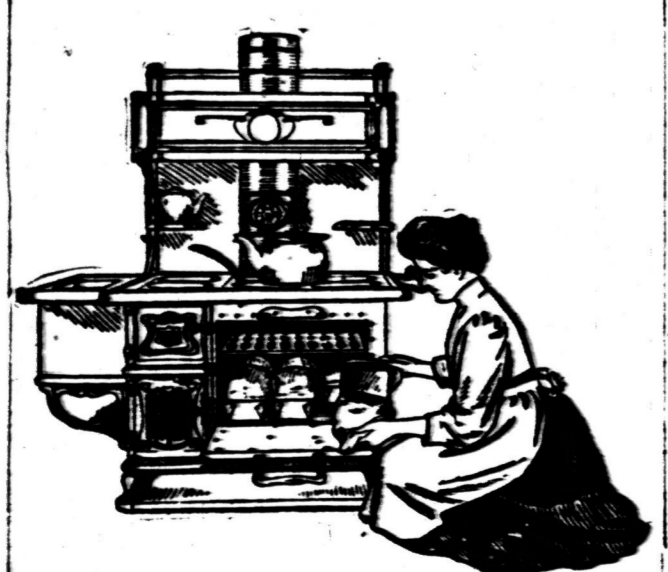
