Drowns Saving Girl and Chum

Harbor Spring, Mich., Aug. 8.—Hal Sowter, nineteen years old of Shelby, Mich., tonight lost his life in Little Traverse bay after saving the lives of his sweetheart, Teresa Miller and his chum Arthur Cook.

Cook and Miss Miller were standing on a reef where they had gone bathing when the undertow from a slicker swept them from their footing. Sowter rushed to their aid and held his two companions above the water until life savers arrived. In the excitement attending the rescue Miss Miller and Cook were hauled aboard the life boat, while Sowter, exhausted by his struggles, and was temporarily forgotten. The circumstances under which Dale Sowter obtained the news of his brother's death were peculiar. The previous evening he and Mrs. Sowter were auto riding with a party of friends in Grand Rapids and were urged to continue for a longer ride, but extended themselves as Mr. Sowter was going to Kalamazoo the next day on business. Mrs. Sowter accompanying him to Plainwell where both expected to remain over Sunday. On the way to the depot in the morning they bought a paper which contained the news that this same party had a few minutes after leaving them, being the victims of a collision injuring five persons so seriously that they were taken to the hospital. While sitting in the train discussing this accident a friend came in and called Mr. Sowter's attention to the despatch in the same paper telling of the Harbor Point tragedy. Hal Sowter was a nephew of W. E. Sowter of this town and a son of A. E. Sowter of Shelby, Mich., also a resident of this town some years ago.
