## HERE AND THERE

The Lehigh Valley Railroad is installing a highway grade crossings danger signals which should prove to be very effective. Both warnings continue to set until the train has passed, when the gong ceases and the red light changes to white. Should the wires become deranged, or should anything happen to the mechanism, the signal on the disc flashes to danger and remains there until repairs are made. Nothing short of actual demolition can prevent the signal from working.

### An Old Norfolk Boy Climbing Up

An old Norfolk boy, whom many of our readers will remember, Dr. Elias Clouse, received a signal honor in Toronto a few days ago, when he was elected dean of the staff of the Western Hospital in that city. Dr. Clouse has been practicing medicine in Toronto for the past twenty years, and holds a high reputation as a surgeon. The hospital staff which has chosen him as their dean consists of forty-eight of the city's physicians. In another sphere Dr. Clouse has taken a prominent place, having been for one year president of the Empire Club. Dr. Clouse is son of Nelson Clouse, who is of United Empire Loyalist descent, while his mother, the late Margaret Beaschem Clouse, was of Highland Scottish stock, and was a cousin of Dr. Livingstone, the African explorer. Dr. Clouse was born in Townsend, and received his early education at the common school, the Simcoe High School and the Woodstock College. He graduated in Medicine from Trinity Medical College, afterwards taking post-graduate courses in Edinburgh and London. On returning to Toronto he was resident surgeon at the General Hospital for a year. Subsequently he became a senior surgeon at the Western Hospital, the staff of which has just recognized his ability and service by electing him as their dean.

### International Safety-at-Sea Conference

The International Conference on Safety at Sea, which was formally opened on November 12, is now in session at the British Foreign Office in London. In a message of welcome King George, who once commanded a British cruiser, says in part: "The question the delegates are about to consider is one in which I take a special interest, for it affects closely the lives and welfare of a vast number of my subjects; and as a sailor I have had personal experience in many of the matters which will come up for consideration by the Conference." The gathering is presided over by Lord Mersey who, it will be remembered, was the president of the British commission which investigated the "Titanic" disaster. The twelve nations represented are Great Britain, Canada, United States, Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Russia, Denmark, Germany, Norway, Spain and New Zealand.
