The poisoned places should be ruhbed briskly, and, if the skin is broken, the effectiveness of the golden rod juice will be increased. Frement applications should be made, and in two or three hours all the soreness and stinging will be gone, If the poison is not recognized until it has a good start it is much harder to cure. Even in this case golden rod will work wonders, but the juice must be more lavishly and frequently applied,"
