**Worst for Fifty Years**

The worst flood in the history of Dunnville for at least fifty years started here Sunday afternoon, and continued all day. The ice jammed behind the long bridge and embankment over the Grand River at this point, back to the water with very little warning. Soon it made a serious break in the embankment along the west end of Dunnville, and a stream of water poured over Main, Lock and Broad streets, filling cellars and doing other damage that will reach many thousand dollars. At midnight dynamite was used to open the embankment in the other side of the river, but this did not seem to have the desired effect. Services in the Baptist, Presbyterian and Anglican Churches could not be held, and in several cases families had to move out of their homes. By evening the flood began to subside a little.

**Why we Have Easter Eggs**

Probably the fact that the egg holds shut in itself, the elements of future life—a life which may be dormant and then come forth into vigor and beauty, into consciousness and activity—made it a proper symbol of the Resurrection. writes Washington Gladden, in *The Woman's Home Companion*. But of all the millions who have decorated eggs at the Easter season or played with them as a pretty toy, or fed upon them as a delicacy, very few have ever stopped to reflect upon the profound meaning of the emblem. In my own boyhood a breakfast of eggs was one of the unwritten regulations of Easter Sunday; the main question with boys was the number per capita that could be consumed. Among us there was none of that dainty decoration with dyes and pigments which has given so much pleasure in old times and new.

This fashion, in the opinion, of an old writer, "arose among the Christians to their joy occasioned by their returning to their favorite food, after so long an abstinence from it during Lent." This is not impossible, for the egg was formerly painted as fresh and denoted good Christians in the Lenten season.

**Good Roads**

Canadian Courier.—The addresses and discussions at the Good Roads Convention recently held, indicate that good roads enthusiasts are getting down to the interest of better highways. A broader and more comprehensive view is being taken of this big question. It is getting beyond the confines of the county and township and becoming a big national question that governments must face, not only by giving financial assistance but by assuming responsibility for the building of roads and their maintenance. Good roads are as important to this country to-day as railways, and it is the duty of the governments to assist the people as much as the other. The granting of the money is not alone sufficient. There is a need for government supervision and responsibility for road building and this cannot be effectively secured except by adopting some comprehensive plan whereby all roads will be provided for, and the provincial government, the county and the township assume a share of the responsibility for roads. One speaker stated at the convention that good roads would never be secured unless the government built them. It is not to be expected that the government could assume responsibility for all roads at the start, though this is the plan followed in some European countries. The plan that would best meet the needs of this country at the present time is for the government to take over the leading roads and divide up the balance with the counties and townships. This would divide responsibility and ease the burden for maintenance on the municipalities.

**Hicks' March Forecasts**

We will venture to put down Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd and 23rd, as constituting a period of great and dangerous disturbances. People in southern parts of the country will do the wise and prudent thing to recognize the probability of equatorial and tornado storms. A proper use of the barometer will give ample and timely warning of approaching atmospheric violence at this time. Phenomenal electrical storms, with rain and hail, will visit many sections, especially the southern states; while blizzards, storms, and gales will sweep down from the north, merge into the storms coming from the south, causing a wide, far-reaching cold wave for March. If there is a general and very low barometer over the southern states, at the on-coming of this period—a thing to be looked for and killing frosts will reach those regions as a sequel to these storms. One of the marked seismic periods of the year is central on the 22nd covering about 18th to the 25th. Note earthquake reports on or about these days. See if seismometers of these forecasts do not find occasion to hedge. A reactionary storm period is central on the 24th, 25th and 26th—coincident with the centre of the Venus period. The probabilities are that a prolonged spell of hard, stormy weather will mar the storm periods at this time but storms will be more pronounced and general on the reactionary days—24th, 25th and 26th. It is reasonably probable that snow blockades will equal or exceed anything of the kind for the whole winter during the last half of March, and notably on the dates of regular and reactionary storm periods. The combined influences of Jupiter and Venus and Earth's Vernal Equinox will almost certainly spring some kind of phenomenal excess upon us! A regular storm period covers the last three days of March, and the first three days of April. The Mercury equinox is added to those of Vulcan, Venus, Earth and Jupiter at this time, so that it is reasonably sure that March will be rough and stormy to the end. The 29th, 30th and 31st will bring decided change to falling barometer, higher temperature and threatening clouds. All these disturbances, at this and other storm periods will develop and organize in western parts of the continent. The government officials, having at their command millions in money, "trained observers," and all necessary telegraphic facilities, ought to be able to point out the paths and apprise the people of the intensity and extent of all these great storm movements.


