

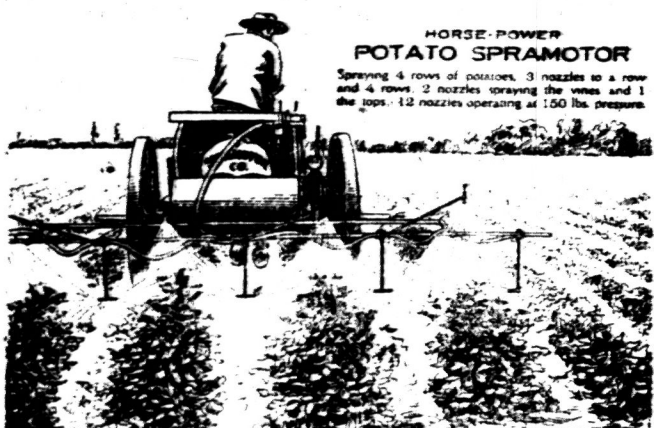

## Not Felt Partner's Sons Enabled the Ladder of Success Without Waiting for the Elevator.

This is a practical story of western success that ought to encourage every red-blooded young man who wants to make something of himself. It's the front and back pages from the business history of four sons of an Ontario farmer who have "made good" in the west. M. McCutcheon then joined their brother in Calgary and upon their arrival the firm of McCutcheon Brothers sprang into existence. In 1901 the fourth brother, J. H. D. Snence, then City Clerk of Calgary, The firm was incorporated as McCutcheon Bros., Limited. This was the genesis of the present real estate business that is now international in its scope. It was hard work for the founders of the firm at first, necessitating even much longer hours than they spent on the farm. Sowing investment seeds was much more difficult than sowing grain. Money was hard to get then. The Goddess of Plenty with the cornucopia, whom artists depict

in the act of emptying date suckles and dollars over the landscape, didn't hover adjacent much at first. However, by zealous effort, the brothers started on their first deal—the sale of a house; then came larger proceeds from the sale of a farm. The firm secured a Calgary property known as "South Balmoral," which sold to their clients for \$75 to \$150 per lot. This property is now worth \$400 to \$600 per lot. "Killarney" lots were sold to their clients for \$65 to 100 per lot and are now worth \$250 to 300 per lot. Success began to bestir success. Grand Trunk was sold at \$75 to \$125 and is now worth \$300 to 500 per lot. North Mount Pleasant sold at \$75 to \$125 and is now worth \$250 to \$350. Altadore sold at \$75 and \$125 and is now worth \$300 to \$400. Knob Hill sold at \$300 to \$250 and is now worth \$700 to \$900 per lot. They reached to other cities. In Edmonton, Beverly Heights lots were sold at \$125 to \$150 and are now worth \$300 to \$500 per lot. Crescent View, Edmonton, was sold at \$125 to \$150 and is now worth \$250 to \$300. Boulevard Heights, Edmonton, was sold for \$150 to \$175 and is now worth \$225 to \$250. In Regina, Rosemount was sold to their clients for \$3.50 to \$400 per lot and is now worth \$500 to \$600. Lynbrook Heights in Moose Jaw were sold to their clients for \$150 to \$200 per lot and is now worth \$200 to 400 per lot. Hillhurst in Moose Jaw was sold at \$100 to 150 per lot and is now worth \$200 to 300 per lot.

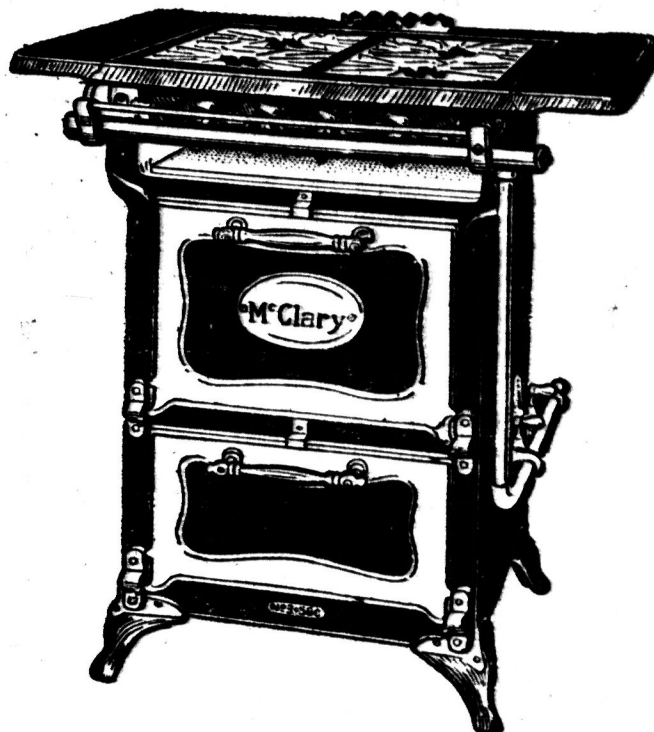
