The funeral took place from his late residence on Wednesday week to the Port Doyer cemetery and was very largely attended. Many floral ributes testified to the esteem in which he was held by his friends and fellow citizens, whose sympathy is cendered to his bereaved relatives, of whom he leaves a family to mourn his departure at the rape old age of 35 years.-Maple Leaf.


