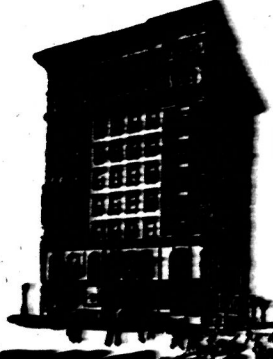

Delhi, May 6.—Fire broke out at one o'clock this morning at Delhi in the storeroom of the Delhi Manufacturing Co., which stood very close to the factory proper. 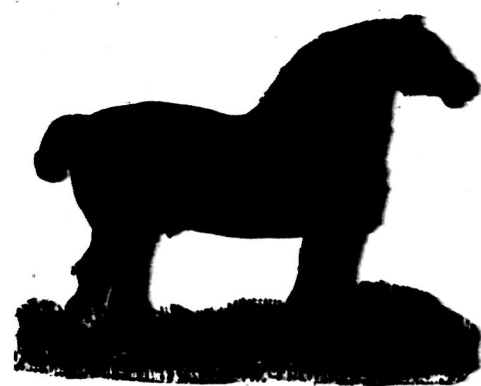
