year saw the exports from Denmark to Great Britain encrease and those of Canada decrease, for at least a decade back. Since that time Denmark has seemingly switched her trade from her friends to the enemy, for in 1915 the exports declined 73,000, pounds. At the same time Canada's exports have been continually on the increase, having been 23.520,861 pounds for the year ending March 31, 1914, 72, 036,025 pounds for 1915 and 144, 150,309 pounds for 1916. Against this had to be recorded a decrease in the last five years in the number of hogs in the country of one million. The facts are given in a phamphlet entitled "The Bac" on Hog and the British Market," by John Bright, Live Stock Commissioner, and H. S. Arkell, Assistant Commissioner, that can be had free on application o the Publication to the Publications Branch, Depart of Agriculture, Ottawa. The author points out that this state of affairs is most unfortunate in the face of he rare opportunity that is offered to urther extend our "Wiltshireside" trade with Great Britain, a trade that for the year ending Dec. 31, 1915, amounted in value to \$15.957,652. While there is a certain demand also for the fat hog, Messra. Eright and Arkell do not tayor increased breeding in that direction for the export trade, as the United States are in a superior position to Canada to

the raising of that particular sort. The bacon hog is onr opportunity, but to take advantage of it we shall have to be more conservative in our methods. As the phamplet says, the word over there exists a confidence in the future of the live stock trade which has no parellel in history. Canada has now the opportunity of placing herself in very powerful position in the export bacon business. The most stable condition of affairs can be brought about by each farmer doing "his bit to increase production without involving himself in any great financial outlay.

#### Feeding Problems

Considering the great lack of succulent stock foods such as silage and roots, and the shortage of barley and corn, many feeders will be at a loss to know what what supplementary foods to buy. This shortage means, especially among dairy farmers, that intelligent use will have to be made of such concentrated foods as oil cake, cottonseed, gluten and other meals.

If you are at a loss to know what to purchase as supplementary foods the local office of the Ontario Department of Agriculture will be able to lend you valuable assistance. Merely state the feeding material you have on hand and the local price of concentrates, and we will be able to advise what to buy and the proper quantities to feed.
