It will be interesting to know that among the ministers of the Hamilton Methodist Conference there are now enlisted six chaplains, and eight sergeants, seven corporals, and nine privates, while from the Methodist members of the conference there are some 5,000 enlisted as privates.

According to Ottawa despatches, Alberta has raised 2,856 more men than her proportion of the 500,000 British Columbia is only 2,100 short and Manitoba and Saskatchewan are short only 7,017. Ontario has yet 41,500, Quebec 105,000, and the Maritime provinces 36,000.

The hot and dry weather that has been hanging over Jarvis for the last three weeks has turned the green lawns to a golden hue, and everything in the form of vegetation shows the effect of the drought. The weather this month has taxed the patience of many who seem unable to get acclimated to the hot continued heat.

A special meeting of the St. Thomas council was held recently to consider a proposition from the Monarch Knitting Company to build a hosiery factory there at a cost of \$50,000. The company asks for a loan from the city of \$30,000, without interest for five years, and a fixed assessment of \$10,000 for ten years. The finance committee decided to put the question before the citizens, and a by-law will be voted on early in August. — Dunnville Chronicle.
