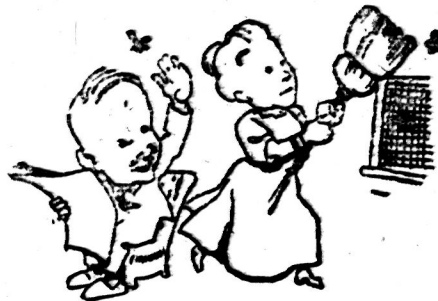

County Council

Continued from Last Week

Pyle-Ingles—That the report of the Good Roads Committee be received and read. Carried.

To the Warden and Members of the County Council.

We, your Good Roads Committee beg leave to report as follows:

1st. That J. I. Case road scraper be repaired at a cost of \$90, and the County to pay freight charges to Toronto and return.

2nd. That we have ordered new wheels for the J. I. Case traction engine.

3rd. We recommend payment of the W. Shirton account of \$50.85 against Robert Duffy.

4th. We recommend no action be taken with regard to a bridge on the 8th Con Walpole Twp. it is claimed by the Municipality of Walpole that this bridge should be assumed and maintained by the County.

All of which is respectfully submitted. Wm. Bain, Chairman.

Anderson-Simonton—That the report of the Good Roads Committee be adopted as read. Carried.

Bain-Clark—That a further sum of \$7,000 be taken up on the credit obtained by the County from the Canadian Bank of Commerce in Cayuga, and that the Warden and Treasurer sign a note for the same. Carried.

Ingles-Pyle—That in the event of Jacob Starnaman making a transfer of his property to the County, this Council will pay the claims of Dr. H. M. Yelland, \$9, and Wm. Logan, \$30, against the said Jacob Starnaman, and also pay the account of Harvey Link, \$16, and Reuben Schwanz, \$50, providing these last two accounts are on investigation found to be correct. Carried.

Pyle Hart—That the report of the Road and Bridge Committee be received and read. Carried.

To the Warden and Members of the County Council.

Gentlemen—We the Road and Bridge Committee recommend the filling in with gravel the low places in each side of the long bridge at Cayuga and to fill up even with the cement wall with earth on right hand side of bridge, also the repairing of abutment. Respectfully

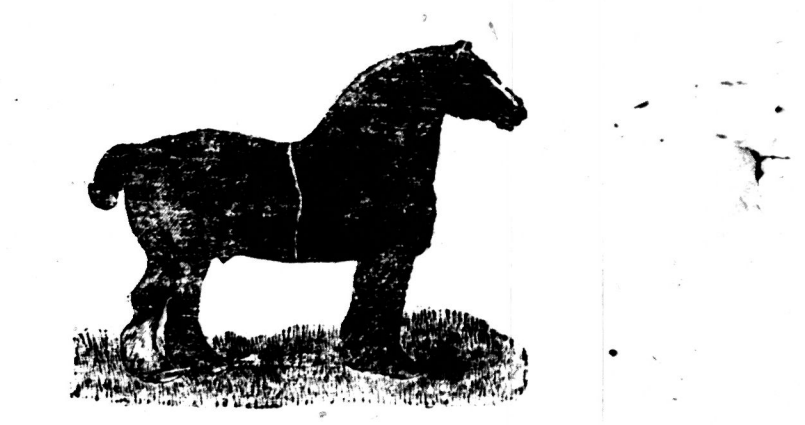
