Muddled Mail Service

The cutting off of the Nelles Corners post office has made considerable change in the mail service between here and the Selkirk district. Formerly mail leaving Selkirk at the early hour in the morning reached Cayuga at 8.30. Now it reaches here at 8 o'clock in the evening. It is carried to Hagersville and lies there until the M.C.R. train from the West brings it in. And to answer that mail directly another day is consumed. Last week we did not know how to send our bundles to Selkirk, so they were sent the usual way. The Selkirk bundles were taken to Fisherville and lay in that office all Thursday, being taken to Hagersville Friday morning and then back to Selkirk. We understand the reason of closing Nelles Corners was that the postmaster asked for an increase, and refused to keep it unless he got it. The Department forthwith ordered it closed. But the change makes it even worse than before for our Selkirk friends, and they surely aren't getting much recognition of their deserts.—Cayuga Advocate.

In Police Court

Yesterday afternoon two former members of the 133rd Battalion, named William Lefir and Alfred Jacobs, neither of whom, however, belong to Norfolk, were in the police court before Squire Earl. The charge against them is that of house breaking and arises out of the evidence adduced at the inquest held on the Alice Block fire in Waterford. The stories told of the escapades of these two youths since they took to soldiering would fill a book. They were remanded for trial at Waterford, before Mr. Earl on Monday day next. The last we heard of them was just before the Battalion left Borden. They were then about half through serving a sentence of 28 days in the clink, given them by Colonel Pratt. Why the civil authorities of Simcoe County did not get after them when that sentence was served, is not easy to understand. One of the most talked about of their adventures was the breaking into a tailor shop in Angus. They helped themselves to two complete officers uniforms, and while dressed in them they were arrested and led down through Camp Borden, with fatigue parties saluting them as they passed. Had they got what they deserved in Simcoe County, they would scarcely have reached Norfolk jail.—Simcoe Reformer.
