Leave Once a Month

A month's order regarding the troop at Camp Borden has gone forth which will direct the 11th All Regiments at a distance from the Camp will have their leave at the one time—and that once a month. Death of John Lishman

John Lishman, a prominent and successful farmer, of Walpole, was killed by a bull at his farm near Gill, on Saturday morning last. The animal had shown symptoms of viciousness the week previous when it had attacked one of Mr. Lishman's sons, injuring his arm. On Saturday Mr. Lishman entered the box stall to bring the animal out and evidently it gave it battle for when the bull appeared it was backing out and Mr. Lishman was using a stick. He was seen to strike it over the head and stooped down to seize a short chain attached to the ring in its nose when it struck him with its head crushing him against a stone wall and then placed its knees upon his chest. An eye witness seized a pitch fork and drove the animal away. Mr. Lishman was in an unconscious condition and when Dr. Playfair arrived medical aid was unavailing and he succumbed to his injuries about an hour later.

John Lishman was born in 1871 on the farm where he met his death and in 1892 married Miss Allison Rowntree. He was a breeder of thoroughbred stock and an extensive shipper, being widely and favorably known throughout the district.

He was a man of sterling qualities, popular among his neighbors and friends. He was a consistent mem-
