Why the West is For Union
By Dr. J. K. UNSWORTH, D.D., of Nanaimo, B. C.

REGARDING Union sentiment in the West you can count on it as solid. The average Westerner man ascribes the hesitation of the Easterner to his ignorance of Western conditions. He himself cannot think in any other terms, ecclesiastically, than Union. In church matters, as in all others, he co-operates readily toward a social objective. This is manifest in the advanced social legislation of the prairies. But the hesitation of the obstructive Easterner is not, as some Westerners think, due to ignorance of conditions, but to his conservative individualism in religion—in church and in other matters. Fine noble, cultured as is Montreal Protestantism, Protestantism has never had elbow room, never the swing and expansion it has found in the West. The overshadowing Roman Catholic Church has prevented the full development of Protestantism towards social unification. It has emphasized traditional methods. It has prevented a full response to the spirit in experimentation. The difference between West and East is not in theology, it is in the social temper, in the co-operative spirit.

For these Westerners, as I said, are entirely social. The wide prairie, the new experiences which unify, the detachment from home and childhood's associations, the predominance of Protestanism, has given them a temper and spirit which cannot fall to be union. If not born in them it is bred. As to this present situation he has been patient with the delay, but has never looked backward. And of movement he expresses regret and hopes it will not grow; but it will not affect him personally. He cannot undo his own personality. Why is there no Winnipeg minister on the list? Even if any of the ministers hesitate, the spirit of their congregations and of the whole community would master them. The average man has settled the matter. Union is taken for granted. There will be no going back.

If these men of the "Presbyterian Association" elect to remain in a denominational church which will wither before their eyes during the next twenty-five years, they and they alone must be ready for the consequences. But the man who has seen that Christianity is a spiritual thing, a spirit to be left free to shape itself afresh in the everchanging enlargement of the human spirit; the man who has been by this war confirmed in his conviction that all forms may go, any unfamiliar adaptation made, if only the objective be attained; the man who holds that the welfare of humanity precedes and shapes the organization of the church. What it is the living man whom we should serve and not antique methods of serving him. These men, to use a Westerner's figure of speech, must unalterably hold the plow handles for granted. There will be no going back. Hold thou to it!

The Ontario Department of Agriculture appeals to Horticultural Societies to devote at least one evening meeting to the subject of vegetable growing; manufacturers, labor unions, lodges, school boards, etc., are invited to actively encourage home gardening. Let the slogan for 1917 be, "A vegetable garden for every home."

Organizations are requested to arrange for instructive talks by practical gardeners on the subject of vegetable growing. In cases where it is impossible to secure suitable local speakers, the Department of Agriculture will, on request, send a suitable man.

The demand for speakers will be great. The number of available experts being limited, the Department urgently requests that arrangements for meetings be made at once; if local speakers cannot be secured, send applications promptly.

The Department suggests the formation of local organizations to stimulate the work by offering prizes for best vegetable garden. It is prepared to assist in any possible way any organization that may be conducting a campaign for vegetable production on vacant lots. It will do so by sending speakers, or by supplying expert advice in the field.

To any one interested, the Department of Agriculture will send literature giving instructions about implements necessary and methods of preparing the ground and cultivating the crop. A plan of a vegetable garden indicating suitable crops to grow, best varieties and their arrangement in the garden, will be sent free of charge to any address.
