Canadian Takes Important Post. In the shape of a number of appointments and recommendations for commissions further recognition has been awarded during the past few days to the University of Toronto training company for officers. Foremost among the appointments of recent date is that of Private H. J. Johnson, who dropped a post with the Carnegie Institute in Washington, D.C., where he was engaged in making a magnetic map of the earth, to train at the University. He has been appointed assistant to the Superintendent of Companies and Compass Adjustment for the Admiralty with the rank of Lieutenant. Since his graduation in mathematics and physics from the University of Torento in 1910 Pte. Johnson has spent some time in Uruguay and Paraguay with a scientific expedition.

Edward Murray Wrong, a graduate of the University of Toronto in 1911, has been appointed Vice-Principal of the School of Technology, Manchester, England. This is one of the greatest of English technical colleges. After leaving the university Mr. Wrong was a student at Oxford University, and at the time of his appointment was Fellow of Magdalene College. He is a son of Professor Wrong, head of the department of history at the University of Toronto.


