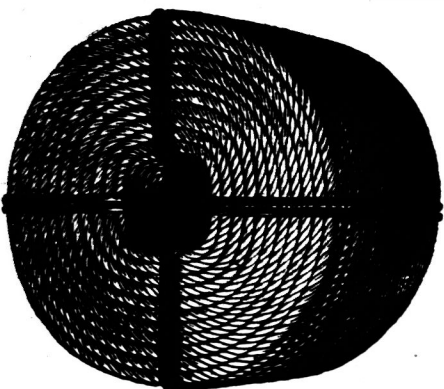

COUNTY COUNCIL

Fourth Session

(Concluded from Last Week.)

Simenton-Anderson—That the report of the Good Roads Committee be received and read. carried.

Cayuga June 7, 1917.

To the Warden and Members of the County Council:

Gentlemen—We, your County Roads Committee, beg leave to report as follows.

1. That we have examined the construction and maintenance accounts presented by the Superintendent, and recommend them for payment.

2. Received from the Superintendent of the G. T. R. a cheque for \$18.75, covering claim for leakage out of a car of stone shipped to Jarvis from Dundas for eighth span culvert, Division 5, October 15, 1916. The cheque has been handed to the Treasurer.

3. That we insure our employees in a Liability Insurance Company and the Superintendent be authorized to attend to same.

4. That permission be given to resurface the street in the village of Jarvis that connects Road no 3, they to pay the County schedule of wages to our employees and \$5 per day for the use of roller and furnish fuel and oil.

5. That we recommend in connection with metalling Division No. 23 that hopper cars be used for hauling stone, and the unloading be done by elevator and gas engine.

6. That instructions be given to dispose all junk that has accumulated since the county system of highways was established, subject to the committee saying what to sell and the price to accept.

7. That the engineer on the gas tractor be allowed to use two graders, providing after giving the experiment a fair trial the Superintendent considers it a paying proposition.

8. That the Superintendent have the necessary repairs to all stone sections on our highway system completed as soon as possible.

9. The Treasurer has received from the Department of Public Highways a cheque for \$8,846.03 on account of the grant of 1916.

10. That we have examined the width of the highway on Division 22 and decided to take no action.

Stewart Clark—That the Building Committee, including the Clerk, be instructed to find out whether this county must have a gasoler, and if not that they proceed to lease the gas to Judge Hopkins at the rate of \$25 per month, the lease to be for five years, and also to attend to the required repairs. carried.

Bain-Smith—That the report of the Finance Committee be received and read. carried.

Cayuga, June 8, 1917.

To the Warden and Members of the County Council:

Gentlemen—We, your Finance Committee, have examined the following accounts and recommend payment of the same:

Maintenance, Construction and General accounts were read.

We recommend that the county rate be 94 mills for 1917 and 1 mill for war tax. Schedule of appropriations hereto attached.
