Roulston-Pyle—That Mr. Lishman, Reeve of Cayuga, be placed on the road and bridge committee, the finance committee being the committee on which the former reeve of Cayuga served. carried.

Sawle-Bradford—That this council do now adjourn to allow the different committees to meet. carried.

Pyle-Roulston—That we resume business with the Warden in the chair. carried.

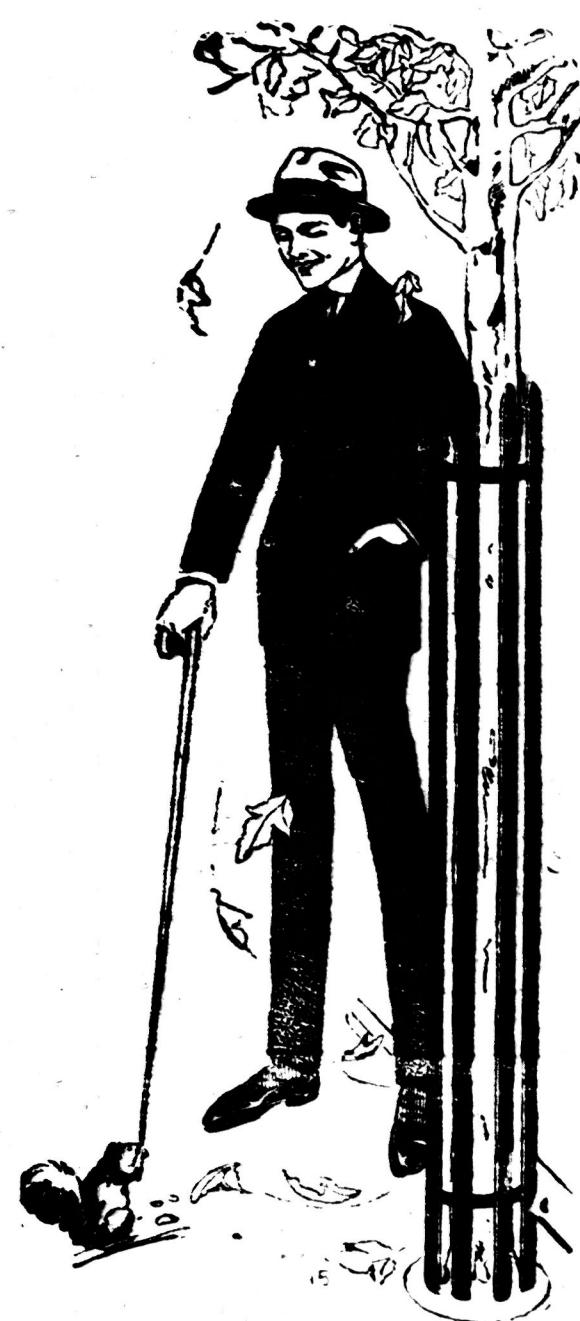
