(From Robert J. Prendergast, London, June 25) One hundred Londoners were killed or wounded during the night of May 29-30, according to semi-official figures. Fighting in London on that night was a real and terrible fighting as the city was in flames. A strong army of fire-eaters is making steady headway in the centre of the town.
