Good-by, Debbin.
Figures compiled by the New York sanitary bureau of the department of health and reported by Harry T. Gardner, secretary of the Automobile Dealers' association, show a great decrease in the number of stables, and, naturally, in the number of horses occupying them. In 1917 there were 108,098 horses. The most recent figures show a shrinkage of 22,086 horses. Chicago, too, shows a falling off in the registration of horse-drawn vehicles under the wheel tax law. In the four years ended May 1, this year, the number of such vehicles decreased from 40,582 to 32,489. This diminution of about 34 per cent compared with New York's falling off of about 30 per cent.
