

Three "Old Scouts" Decorated. During his visit to Ontario, Sir Robert Baden-Powell conferred upon three of the leaders of Canadian Scouting membership in the Boy Scout Order of the Silver Wolf. They were Dr. Franklin H. Gilborne, Mr. Gilbert E. Fauquier and Dr. James W. Robertson.

The presentation of the insignia took place at the Annual Meeting of the Canadian General Council which was held in the Parliament Buildings, Ottawa, on March 28th.

Dr. Gilborne is the Chairman of the Dominion Medal Board, the special committee which passes on all applications for awards for life saving and other meritorious actions by Scouts. In accepting his decoration, Dr. Gilborne said, "Had this been recommended in the ordinary way I would have felt duty bound to have rejected the recommendation. However, commensurate opportunity."

Mr. Gilbert E. Fauquier is a member of the Executive Committee of the Provincial Council for Ontario and a former President of the Council itself. He is also a member of the Executive Committee of the Canadian General Council and devotes his special attention to the work of the Committee on Scouting in Canada. Dr. James W. Robertson is Canada's Chief Scout Commissioner. Sir Robert presented him with the Silver Wolf at an assembly of Scouts in Ottawa on Saturday, March 31st. During the proceedings someone in the vast audience called for cheers for Dr. Robertson and the response was immediate and long and lusty as only a thousand and boyish voices can make it. Before the applause had subsided, Sir Robert took off his own Silver Wolf and placed it around the doctor's neck—an action which was but a signal for an even greater demonstration in recognition of the wonderful services the Chief Commissioner has given to Scouting in Canada.

The Shape of the Earth.

A French scientific finds in the great depths of the Arctic Ocean an argument tending to show that the earth is slightly topographed, the protuberance corresponding to the point of the top being at the South Pole. This, he thinks, would explain the different results arrived at by the various measurements of the circumference and geodesists. The differences are very small in comparison with the entire bulk of the globe, yet they are readily appreciable, and one of the explanations that has been suggested for them is that the earth is tetrahedral in shape. The Frenchman thinks the fact that an eye looking at the earth from a point in space it would not seem to differ in appearance from a true sphere shows how refined are the methods of science which enable men living on the surface of the globe to detect variations in its general contour.

EASY TRICKS The Sigmatic Card No. 26



Tell your friends that in the playing card world, the joker is a natural detective. Prove it in this manner:

Ask a spectator to select any card from the pack, to look at it and to place it on the top of the pack. Ask him to put the lower cut on the upper. Ask him to do this several times until he himself does not know where the card he selected is to be found.

Explain that you will ask the joker to disclose the identity of the selected card. Look through the pack, find the joker and hold it to your ear, pretending that the card is whispering to you. "Ah! The joker says that you selected the ten of diamonds."

That is correct. The secret is simple. Observe the bottom card of the pack. The spectator puts his card on the top. When the cards are cut, the card you observed will precede the bottom card. No matter how many times the cards are cut the two cards will be in that relation to each other. When you look through the pack for the joker, look for the card you observed. The following card will be the selected one and you are ready for the finish of the trick.


