



Suppose King Totankhamen had sent an expedition to find the North Pole: Let it be imagined that the goal was reached and that a post was driven into the ground to mark its exact location. Amundsen, if successful in his present project would not find the Pole in the same spot as it was 3,500 years ago, but it would not be far away.

From a given centre, suppose circle to be drawn from a radius of thirty feet. Inside of that circumfer-
