SWINDLER GETS TERM

John Huntley Debauched Great Many Merchants. Bold Operator in Worthless Cheques Victimised Business Men in All Parts of Canada

TORONTO, Feb. 12.—Wanted throughout Canada on numerous charges of uttering bogus cheques and victimising business people to the extent of hundreds of thousands of dollars, John Huntley, a man of many aliases, has temporarily finished his career as cheque artist

Shortly before his arrest, however, a policeman was murdered in Montreal. Wallace, then in duration at Burwash, told the authorities there that Huntley was the man who had murdered the officer

Released from prison in British Columbia, Huntley returned to the east, where he again resumed his plots with pen and cheque led to the victimization of a local firm and steel manufacturer and various other business people to the tune of several hundred dollars

Inspector Guthrie of Toronto stated Saturday that the police were of the belief that Huntley was a hijacker
