Why is a Foxglove?

We use the names of our common flowers and plants so frequently and so heedlessly that few of us ever stop to think of the derivations of these names. Yet there is no other class of words in the English language which we have collected more haphazardly from every other language in the World

Take the dandellor, that common but wonderful flower which blooms all the year round; its name is pure French. Mallow is Greek. Artichoke is from an Arabic word meaning "earth thorn." Rhubarb is Latin, and bean Anglo-Saxon, while potato is really a Spanish word.

Some flower names have their origin plainly stamped on them. "Coltsfoot," for inetance, is also called "Foalfoot." Its hoof-shaped leaf quite evidently gave it its common name. Bachelor's Button, again, shows the origin of its name in the shape of its button-like flower. Similarly "knap weed," which is really "knob" weed.


