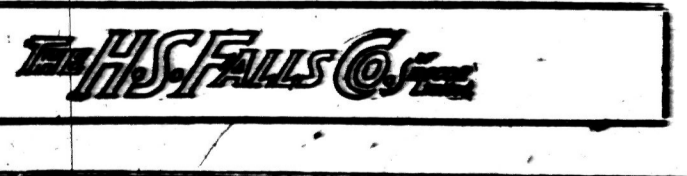

One day, when Professor Powell was hearing the class in anatomy, he was describing the manner in which the various muscles of the scalp perform their several functions, says ex-Gov. Theodore T. Geer, reminiscence of his school days, in "Fifty Years in Oregon." To make the subject clearer, the professor told the members of the class to move their scalps by aid of the muscles without moving the head, and proceeded to lead the way by giving a personal demonstration.

In an address by Principal Reynolds of the O. A. C., the other day, the following graphic comparisons were made: A farmer requiring a mower in 1914 could obtain one in exchange for 700 pounds of beef; in 1921 it was necessary for him to deliver 1,500 pounds for the same implement.

A seed drill in 1914 was the equivalent of 166 bushels of oats; it represents 416 bushels of oats in 1921. In the latter year 200 bushels of wheat were required in exchange for a binder, which could have been obtained for 133 bushels seven years before.

A gang plow could then be had for 774 pounds of pork, but in 1921 the farmer would have to deliver 1,200 pounds in exchange for the plow. The farmer seeking a two-horse cultivator in the earlier year transferred 39 bags of potatoes in the exchange; in the later year he had to bring 136 bags to the market place.

Eight night schools and four dormitories are provided for Chinese in Canada by the Methodists. Trinity, New York, the "world's wealthiest Anglican parish," announced lately that its income for 1922 was \$1,249,870.71.

There are no less than 450 Baptist churches in Siberia, with a membership within the Siberian Baptist Union of 200,000 to 300,000. The Ongole Baptist Mission in So. India, has baptised 250,000 converts in fifty years.

The Canadian Methodist circuit system in West China includes ten stations and 94 outstations, with 17 street chapels. Canadian Methodists have 571 missions with 626 workers among white, yellow, red and black folk in Canada, Newfoundland, Labrador and Bermuda.
