**TAX ON GASOLINE NEW SUGGESTION**

Toronto, April 2.—That a tax on gasoline and heavier imposts on motor trucks and high-speed cars may be introduced at the next session of the legislature was intimated by Francis Ferguson, in replying to a deputation representing various municipalities in Ontario that waited upon him, to ask that municipalities receive some of the proceeds collected by the province in amusement taxes and from race-course meets. The deputation also suggested that aid, probably in the form of a gasoline tax, should be given municipalities, to assist road expenditures.

The premier said that he could promise nothing this year, but held out hope for some relief in the years following.
