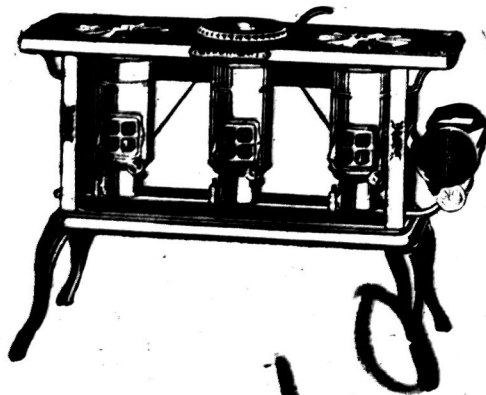

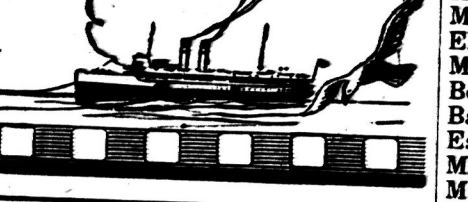
AFTERNOON SAIL TO TORONTO

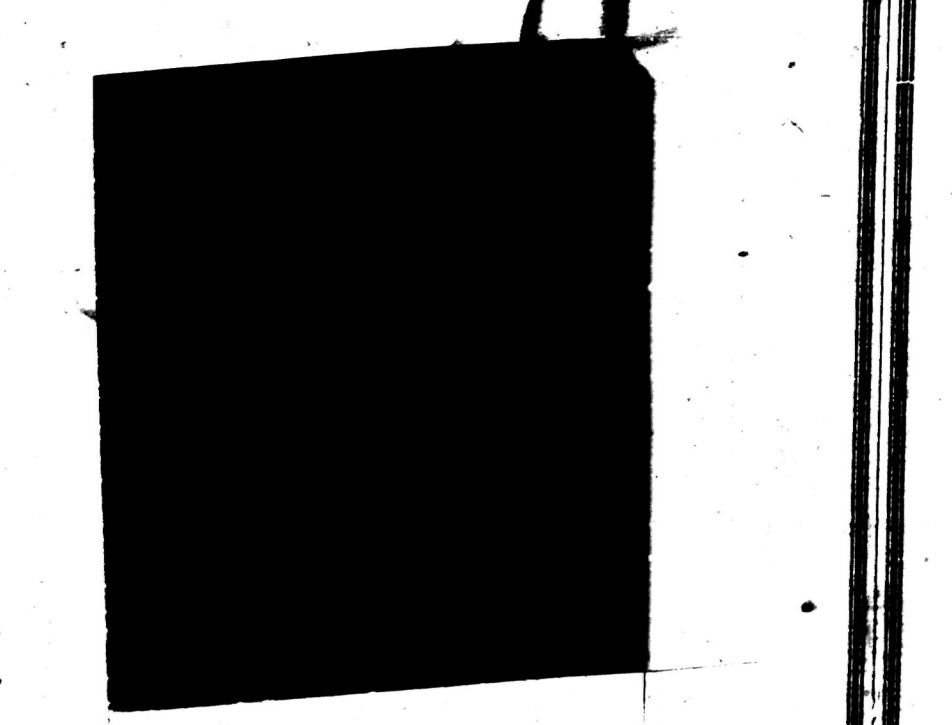
