Last week at a baseball game we ceased rooting long enough to protest against the action of a pill-shooter deliberately dropping a burning butt through the tinder-dry plankings to the roof of a small building below. The lives and safety of five thousand persons was endangered by the act of the brainless idiot and he was told so while an attendant was extinguishing the blaze,

A pill-shooter who throws a cigarette stub where it causes or may cause the loss of human life is criminally insane and should be restrained in surroundings where he is not a public menace.
