LICENSING ALL DRIVERS AND LIGHTING VEHICLES

Toronto, Nov. 28.—Licensing of all drivers of motor vehicles, lights upon all vehicles upon the public highways after dark, educational campaigns by the provinces upon the dangers of level railway crossings, and federal aid towards road construction were propositions upon which the delegates to the inter-provincial road conference reported favorably Thursday at the Parliament buildings prior to adjourning their sessions. The matters had been thoroughly discussed during the three days' deliberations of the gathering, and the intention is that, where they come within the scope of provincial legislation or regulation, uniform laws upon them will be sought from all provincial governments.

The delegates to the meeting which reached these conclusions were the highway ministers, deputy ministers, highway engineers and other highway and motor vehicle officials of the provincial governments, together with the executive officers of the Canadian Good Roads association. They gave exhaustive study to various highway and motor problems with a view to securing uniformity of legislation throughout the country and with a view also to serving the interests of the pedestrian, motor vehicle and transportation in this principle of licensing every motor vehicle driver and of requiring all vehicles to carry lights upon the public highways were endorsed in the interests of public safety.

Also upon the same score level crossings were given careful study and it was urged that provincial governments should educate their public upon their dangers, and should pass legislation requiring motor vehicles to slow down to a speed of 15 miles per hour in approaching them. It was pointed out that 20,000 grade crossings existed in Canada and that 10 per cent. of them could be classed as extremely hazardous.

Other recommendation which were approved in order to promote safety, favored the compulsory stoppage of busses before proceeding across railway crossings and the designation of arterial or main roads, at which all vehicles would be compelled to come to a full stop before crossing.

Discussing the financing of roads, the meeting approved the following resolution upon the subject of federal aid: "Be it resolved that since highway development and improvement is today of national importance and since the Federal Government benefits directly and indirectly by the expenditure on roads which are being made by the provinces, and since the

customs duties which have been collected on automobile accessories and parts has totaled nearly \$100,000,000, and since it is our firm conviction that those who benefit should contribute, that we hereby re-affirm our belief in the principle of federal aid to the provinces for road purposes."
