TRACTORS DAMAGING HIGHWAY

Are Liable to Prosecution Under the Highway Traffic Act

A provision of the Highway Traffic Act effecting owners of tractors and threshing outfits, but not generally known to those concerned, was brought out in Barrie Police Court the other day when Magistrate Jeff convicted Frank Steele, of Gifford, of damaging the new Provincial Highway with the flanges of the wheels of the tractor and remanded him to jail called on.

Mr. F. Steele did not appear, but through his counsel acknowledged the breach of the act. Mr. Grant of the Highway Traffic Branch was present from Toronto in connection with the case and, while not wishing to press for a heavy fine, he asked for the conviction as a warning to other threshers.

On being asked how farmers living along the highway are to get their crops threshed if the threshers cannot use the highway, Mr. Grant said that on the highway in York County and on the Kingston Road threshers and owners of tractors are using blocks on the rear wheels that protect the highway from damage from the flanges. These blocks, he said, give perfect satisfaction and can be removed when the tractor reaches soft ground where the grip of the flanges is necessary to make progress.

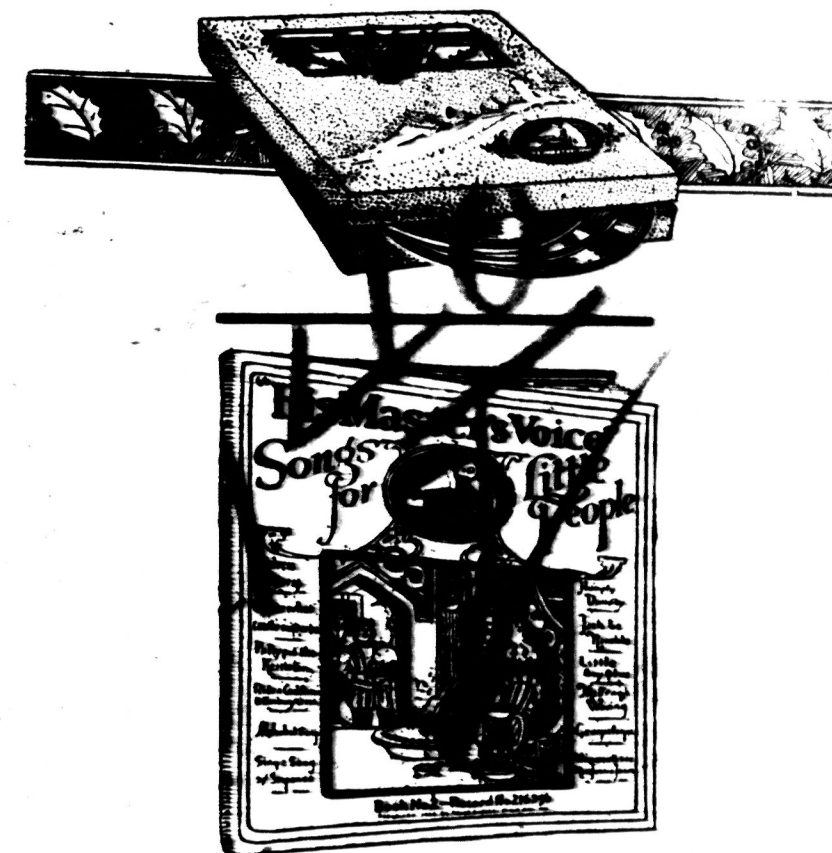
