The Strike

There is a well-founded suspicion that the grievances of the postal employees could have been adjusted, before the men had reached the extremity of a strike, if it were not for politics.

It is a serious matter to permit politics to affect the supply of bread and butter for the children of post office employees.

The men long have had a serious complaint. The report of the Civil Service Commission, after investigation, did nothing but aggravate the situation and the government at Ottawa up to the moment the strike was called did little to mend matters.

The men may have made a mistake to strike. It is seldom that a strike in the public service is to be condoned, but in this instance, it appeared necessary for the men to walk out in order to bring the government's attention to the extremities to which these hard-working public servants had been driven in attempting to subsist on starvation wages.

Homeward Bound

Evidence that many Canadians are returning from the United States is shown by statistics now being compiled by the department of immigration and colonization, the total for the last two months being nearly 5,000.

It was not until towards the end of last March, that the immigration officials began to make an accurate check on the number of Canadians who were coming back after being in the United States six months or longer.

In April returns from 148 out of the 171 points along the international boundary at which there are Canadian immigration inspectors showed that 4,081 Canadian citizens returned to their own country.

In May the number from 129 ports was 4,839, with 42 ports to be heard from.

Would Make All Roads Provincial

Strong application to the Department of Public Highways by several municipalities to have the various provincial roads throughout the county repaired and made safe for traffic. Some of these roads are in a deplorable condition and dangerous, and it is being claimed that the Department should get busy not only to make the highways safe, but also to safeguard the public money invested in these roads.

At a meeting of the Good Roads Committee of the Legislature in Hamilton they were asked to make Welland County roads provincial highways in view of the heavy tourist traffic from the other side of the line. Should this be done the county would only be called upon to pay 40 per cent. instead of 60 per cent. of the maintenance costs.

Decisions Respecting Newspapers

Any person who takes a paper regularly from the post office, whether addressed to his name or another's or whether he has subscribed or not, is responsible for payment. If a person orders his paper discontinued he must pay all arrears or the publisher may continue to send it until the payment is made, and then collect the whole amount whether the paper is taken or not. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers or periodicals from the post office or removing and leaving them unpaid, is prima facie evidence of intention of fraud.
