#### THE SMUTS OF GRAIN CROPS

Oats (1) Loose Smut of Oats  
(2) Covered Smut of Oats  
Wheat (1) Stinking Smut or Bunt  
(2) Loose Smut of Wheat  
Barley (1) Naked or Loose Smut of  
(2) Covered Smut of Barley

#### Treatment—Oat Smuts

Material Required:—  
One-quart sprayer. Bags or Blankets  
Shovel. 1 pint Formalin  
Clean Floor. 1 pint Water

The above material will treat fifty bushels of oats. The oats are piled on a clean floor. As one man turns the oats over, another man sprays the grain with the formaline solution. After the oats have been treated, they are covered with sacks or blankets and left for five hours. The sacks should be sprayed both inside and out. Then bag the grain which is ready to sow at once. Leave the oats covered for the full five hours because it is the fumes from the formalin that kills the spores.

#### Treatment—Loose Smut of Wheat and Naked or Loose Smut of Barley

The above smuts can not be prevented by treating with formaline. Purchase clean seed that you know is free from either smut.

#### Treatment—Stinking Smut or Bunt Smut of Wheat and Covered Smut of Barley

Material Required:—  
Barrel  
40 gals. water  
Shovels for mixing grain  
Ordinary garden sprinkling can  
1 pint formalin

Place the grain to be treated in a heap on a clean floor. Sprinkle the formalin solution over the grain. Then shovel the grain into another pile so as to mix it thoroughly. Then sprinkle and shovel again. Repeat until every grain is moistened by the solution. Cover the pile with sacks or blankets that have been sprinkled with formalin solution and leave for three or four hours. At the end of this time, spread the grain out to dry; shovel it over several times to hasten the drying. Forty gallons of the formalin solution is sufficient to sprinkle between fifty and sixty bushels of grain.

#### General Precautions

1. Follow instructions in detail.
2. Great care must be taken to see that treated grain is not re-infected with smut spores. Sacks, bins and implements used in handling smutted grain must also be disinfected.
3. Sow the seed as soon as possible after treatment.
4. On no account allow the treated grain to sprout, mould or be frozen when swollen after treatment.

#### Formaline

Formaline is a forty per cent. solution of formaldehyde gas in water. It can be purchased from any drug-
