

EASY TRICKS Where Strength Doesn't Count



Hand to a spectator a spool of cotton thread. Ask him to double the thread and to see whether or not he can break it with his fingers. He will find little difficulty in doing this, although the thread selected for the trick should be strong enough to make him exert a little strength.


