present in most insects. If the compound eye of a house fly be placed under the low power of the microscope the surface will appear marked off in hexagonal areas. These are the ends of coues, each of which may function as a separate eye.

The queen bee has five thousand of them, the drone twelve thousand, the dragon fly twenty thousand, and some heetles twenty-five thousand. The simple eyes, called ocelli, lovated near the middle of the forehead, are just visible to the naked eye in such large forms as the locust in which there are three. These are probably used for


