### Here and There

At a well service between Windsor and North Bay, Ontario, has been reported and the first mail for Windsor from the United States at about recently.

The Sheraton, King of the Hotel, recently sold from the Commission of H. H. H. the Prince of Wales to a United States house, again, was the greater prize at the Calgary Exhibition.

Withness of the removal of interest of 100 Country Inventors in Western Canada are seen in a number of patent transactions recorded at Windsor, including the proposed creation of three machine patents houses by means of English capital.

Madame Bonaparte, when clearing his farm south of Vernon on the Canadian Pacific line, found a 300-lb. boulder which was half native silver and worth about \$1,200. The discovery has aroused considerable interest among mining men in Cobalt and elsewhere who are arriving in numbers.

London, Ontario, now has an air harbor. Through efforts on the part of the Chamber of Commerce an ideal air-field site has been taken over and, within a month's time, will be completely equipped and ready on as to provide an air depot available to all planes that seek London as a stopping place.

According to a financial statement issued from the headquarters of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company, the gross earnings of the Company for the first six months of the year ended showed an increase of \$5,614,773.05. The net profit, however, decreased about \$200,000 due to a four million dollar increase in the working expenses for that period.

Quebec City lived up to its tradition as the historic gateway and welcomed their Royal Highnesses the Prince of Wales, Prince George and Princess and Mrs. Baldwin with a tremendous burst of enthusiasm and a blaze of color. Vast crowds thronged the docks and waterfront on the Canadian Pacific S.S. Empress of Australia, bearing the distinguished visitors to Canada, steamed into sight.

Experiments in rust prevention by means of spraying chemical over wheat fields from airplanes is about to be tried out in Manitoba, under the direction of the Dominion Government Department of Agriculture. The chemical used is merely sulphur in a colloidal state, technically known as "Calc." It is said that one plane can treat 5,000 acres a day, flying at a height of 50 feet. The machine will carry 700 lbs. of chemical in the mechanical spraying apparatus.

"Austrian bankers have discovered that with the use of Canadian flour they can make more and better bread. The prohibition of night-baking also favors the employment of fast-baking flour," says the Commercial Intelligence Journal, Ottawa. Frederick Prusner, Austrian Consul, says his country is negotiating with Canada for a trade treaty with Canada; for, while the war reduced Austria's population from 54,000,000 to 6,000,000 the city of Vienna has still 2,000,000 to feed.
