

Hon. John S. Martin, Minister of Agriculture, states that the Ontario round 200 Bay St. Toronto. Government is prepared to co-operate with the Dominion Government in establishing a fund for the advertising of Canadian apples on British markets. P. W. Hodgetts, head of the Gueen West. Toronto. Fruits Branch of the Dept., will go to Ottawa on July 6 to attend a conference of fruit growers, apple shippers sellers, exclusive territory, highest commissions paid and various Provincial Government white for full particulars. 
