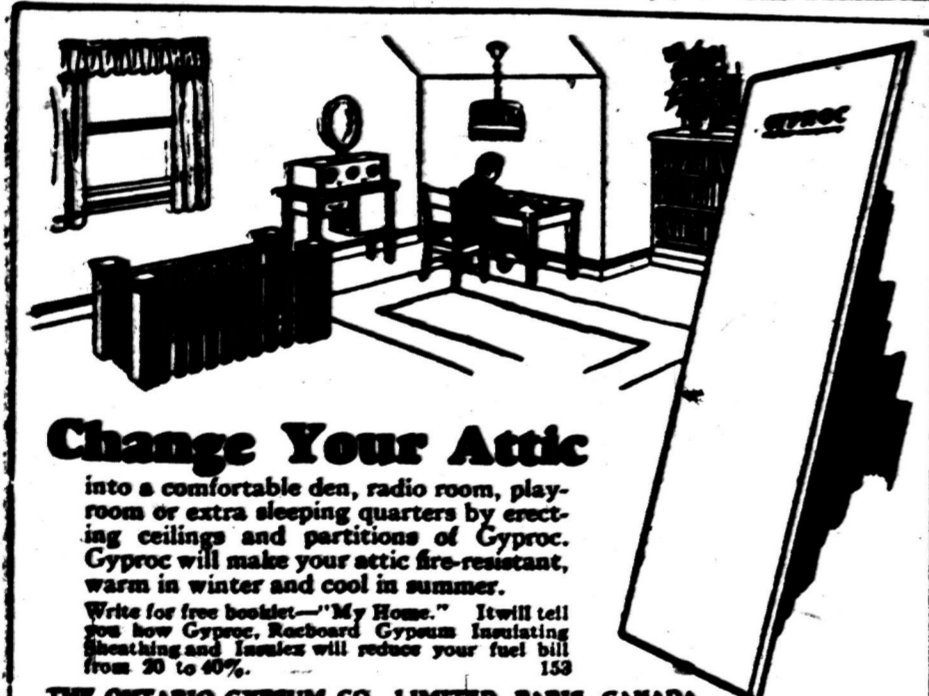

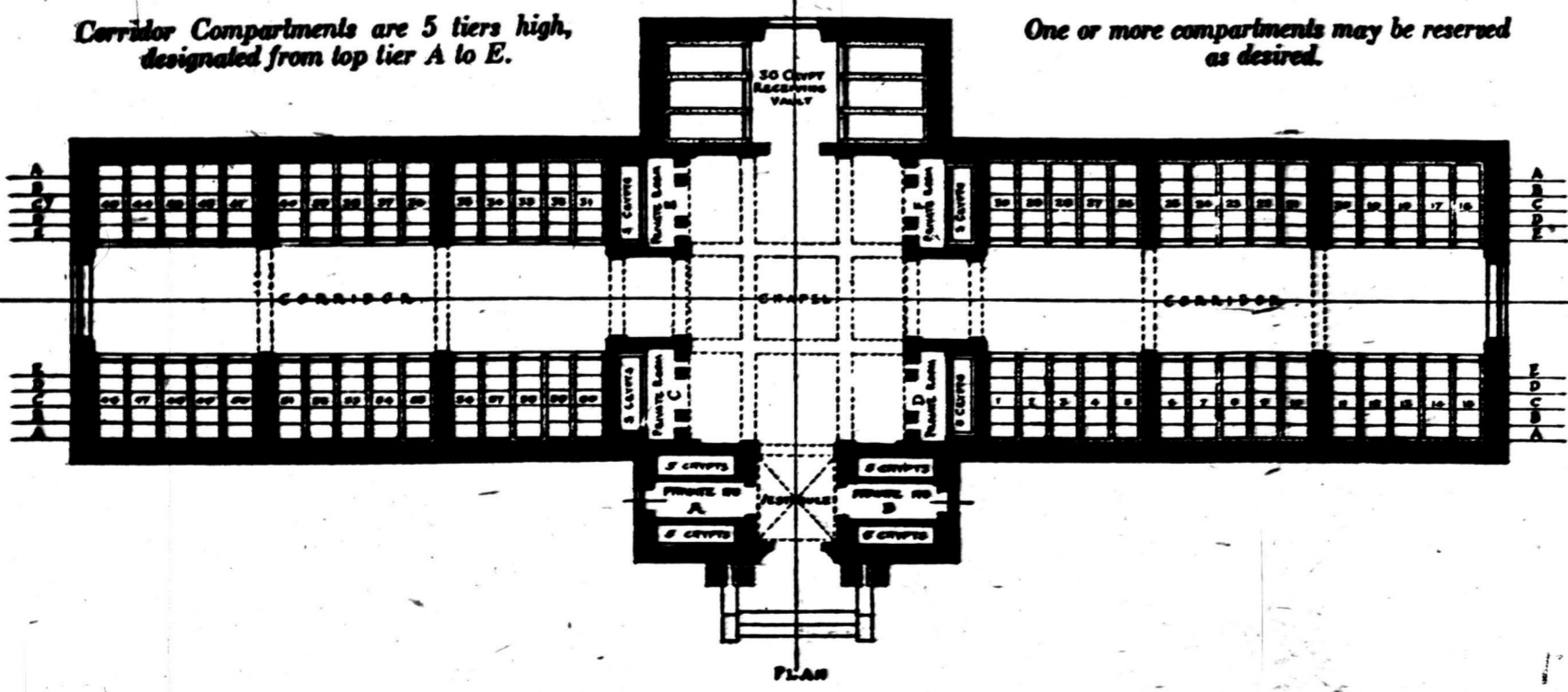

We present above a crypt plan of the new Port Dover Mausoleum. The plan enables the purchasers to choose the location of the compartments they prefer. The bottom of the cut faces the Port Dover-Simcoe highway. Turning to the right from the entrance the tiers are numbered from one to 30, and crossing the Ceremonial Chapel to the left from 31 to 60. The letters on the plan designate the tiers, A being the highest and E the lowest. In the basement the 30 crypts receiving vault shown is for temporary burial only—is: during excessive frosts, spring flooding or in the event of bodies being brought from a distance, the remains may be deposited here till weather conditions permit burial in the earth. The Chapel, in the center, is always available for services for the dead, whether entombed in the Mausoleum or buried in the earth, a feature which appeals powerfully to the public. In addition to the compartments in the main corridors, six private rooms are shown, and in many mausoleums magnificent decorative effects are obtained for purchasers who desire more elaborate architectural results—but even these effects are permitted only when they harmonize with the general tone of simplicity, dignity and solemnity which must characterize a memorial building of this type.

Held in Peacock's Hall, Jarvis, Nov. 23, 1927 to Feb. 24, 1928, From 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Every Week Day Except Saturday

Young men of Jarvis district, this is your opportunity for a practical education.

The value of the course to you may be stated as follows:

1. Full course in Live Stock, judging, feeding, management, breeding, buildings, equipment, etc.
2. Practice will be given in judging wheat, oats, barley, peas, corn, potatoes, clovers, grasses, etc. Also recommended varieties, production of seed, cleaning, grading, marketing, etc.
3. A study of the breeds of farm poultry, poultry houses, operation of an incubator and brooder, the rearing of young stock, feeding poultry, killing, plucking, egg grading, poultry diseases, etc.
4. Teaches dairying, including sanitary milk production, milk and cream testing, cream separators, keeping of milk records, etc.
5. Teaches the care and management of bees.
6. Live stock diseases and how to control them.
7. Teaches all about farm buildings, farm water supply and sewage disposal, ropes, knots and splices, the use of concrete and how to solder.
8. Teaches the general principles of the gasoline engine and tractors, engine troubles and how to locate and remedy them.
9. O careful study of soils, drainage, fertilizers and their adaptation to the home farm.
10. Identification of weeds and weed seeds, methods of eradication and treatment of diseases of field crops, such as smuts, rusts, etc.
11. Instruction is given in the care of the vegetable garden and the orchard as well as sprays and spraying.
12. A full discussion of any farm problems which the students have on their home farms.
