Poincare Sure France Not to Blame

Wishes to Prove France Was Not Instigator of World War

Paris.—Premier Raymond Poincare is determined to delve deep into the French archives and to publish documents relative to the origin of the war. His determination took tangible form yesterday when the committee appointed in January by governmental decree met for the first time and planned the immediate editing of two volumes.
Poincare personally is interested in the production of proof to clear France of charges that she started the war. Poincare's visit to Russia immediately before the war was always cited by the German historians as an indication that he (then President of France) was brewing trouble.

Foreign Minister Aristide Briand has informed the committee that all the archives of the Foreign Office are at its disposition including many hitherto kept in strict secrecy.
The committee has decided that its report will cover the period 1871-1914—from the end of the Franco-Prussian war to the beginning of the Great War. It will begin the editing of two series, the first covering events from 1901 to November, 1911, the second from that date until August, 1914. After that it will include the third series, taking in the 30 years from 1871 to 1901.

A Well-Known Canadian Jurist Reviews Sacco-Vanzetti Case


The full proceedings of the Sacco-Vanzetti case were submitted to the Hon. William Renwick Riddell, Justice of the Court of Appeals, Ontario, and Honorary Member of the American Bar Association, and he gives his view of the case in March Current History Magazine. His conclusions, summarized, are as follows:
"1. That no evidence was wrongly excluded or admitted.
"2. That the evidence which was considered to be so fatal to the accused (to the effect that they were Radicals) was given by themselves against the advice of the trial Judge in necessary explanation of their previous 'wholesale lying.'
"3. That neither Judge nor prosecuting counsel was guilty of misconduct before the jury.
"4. That there was a fair trial.
"5. That there was ample evidence upon which a jury might convict.
"6. That there is nothing but subsequent declamation and vituperation to suggest prejudice or failure to perform their duty on the part of the jury.
"7. That the refusal of the motions for a new trial cannot be held erroneous.
"8. That the great delay in executing the sentence was due to the motions made by the condemned men and the extraordinary tenderness of the law of Massachusetts in respect of one convicted of crime applying to her courts for protection from injustice."

Justice Riddell analyzed all the documents with a detached mind and states he had never met the trial Judge or any of the participants in the trial.




Emigration of Britons Discussed

Hesitation Over Absorption in Canada is Deplored—Regard British as Flow-er of World Immigrants

London.—Henry Page Croft in the course of a letter in the "Morning Post," with reference to emigration says:
"It is a strange thing that while the Dominions need, above everything else, a greater population and a larger number of taxpayers and taxpayers to get increased purchasing power in their home markets, the United States apparently regard the British as the flower of the world immigrants and the new American immigration bill is more than doubling the quota of Britons."
"It is surely, then, deplorable that while the United States thinks it fit to double the quota of British there is hesitation and difficulty of absorption of our people among our own folk and kin. Perhaps much of this is due to a lack of appreciation of the benefits derived from the settlement overseas of our own folk. The suggestion was recently made that an Empire Settlement Publicity Board be appointed on the line of the Empire Marketing Board, but helpful only if the operations are extended to the Dominions—perhaps the most desirable thing to do in connection with the new Empire Settlement Bill in the House of Commons is to alter the 50-50 principle so that the Secretary of State shall have power to contribute on a discretionary basis up to 99 per cent."

Pringle Challenged.
James Pringle, of the Royal Colonial Institute, in a letter to the "Daily Telegraph," challenges the allegation of C. Pringle that Canada presently prefers Central Europeans to Britishers. He says: "Can Pringle reconcile his observations with the utterance of any responsible statesman in Canada?" The assertion of preference for immigrants of British stock is incessant, and the Briton, especially the Scot, has shown repeatedly he is capable of adapting himself to the difficult conditions of prairie farming, provided he is of the type on which Canadians rightly insist.



Russia's New Educational Program

The new Soviet school system is being built up with the interests of the contemporary child, the child's concrete environment and experience as a basis," writes Mme. N. K. Krupskaya, Lenin's widow and officer in the Soviet Ministry of Education, in March Current History. "The object of this educational program is to teach the relation between nature, the working activity of man and the social system, set forth on the basis of very simple concrete facts. . . . The instruction aims to keep in touch with the life of the people, with what both the grown-ups and the children hold closest to their hearts. . . . The material taught is linked up with practical work in the school and at home, and the children study such subjects as helping the pre-school pupils, the organization of minors, the teaching of reading and writing to the illiterate population, the distribution of newspapers, sanitation, new methods of cultivation and caring for animals. Training in workshops and factories is also part of the program but has not been worked out as fully due to lack of resources. . . . Harsh treatment of the children in school is strictly forbidden and school discipline is inculcated in the inner consciousness of the pupils rather than maintained by force, thus affording valuable training in self-government."

Evolution Teaching Still Live Issue

"Although it is continually asserted that the Dayton trial and Bryan's death ended the teaching of evolution, this is far from being the case," asserts Maynard Shipley, President of the Science League of America, in March Current History Magazine. "Not only has Mississippi passed a bill on the same lines as Tennessee's, but the Tennessee law has been proclaimed constitutional. Louisiana, Arkansas and Florida have passed anti-evolution acts in the lower house, which only prompt playing of politics prevented from passage in the Senate. Moreover, such a bill in Missouri obtained a very respectable and dangerous minority in its favor and in several proud Northern and Western States there was, in 1927, far more anti-evolution sentiment than there now specially concerned with research into the situation could readily imagine. The mere fact that bills were before fourteen States in one year sounds ominously like the first decided effort toward the passage of the Eighteenth Amendment."

17 Countries Still Permit Slave System

Up to 5,000,000 Slaves Said to Be Employed by Backward Nations

London.—"Although the horn under the flag of Great Britain are born free, there are to-day 4,000,000 to 5,000,000 slaves, and 17 countries in which the slave system still exists."
Sir Henry Bantick made this grave assertion at a meeting of the film version of "Uncle Tom's Cabin" at the London Pavilion. In Abyssinia, Sir Henry continued, there were 2,000,000 slaves. These were obtained by the same old methods of slave trading, by bands of armed men entering peaceful villages and carrying off the inhabitants. Abyssinia, as a member of the League of Nations, had agreed to abolish slavery within her borders, but owing to confusion and misrule the slave system in that country has got worse rather than better.
In China there were no less than 2,000,000 slaves who continued in subjection owing to the present confusion in spite of the fact that China was also a member of the League of Nations.
Not long ago, in Geneva, all the nations of the world formed a convention and agreed to abolish slavery. So far the countries had not agreed to declare slave trading on the sea as piracy. There was still much work, therefore, for England and America to do in the way of liberating slaves.

Afghan Ruler Sees Mock Battle
Lulworth, Dorset, England.—Modern methods of western warfare are "unromantic and terrifying" in the opinion of King Amanullah of Afghanistan, the fighting methods of whose native country are still largely of a primitive nature.
The King who went down in a submarine at Portsmouth motored here from Bourne mouth with Queen Soraya and watched a mock battle of British tanks on a windswept hillside. The Afghan monarch produced a pocket camera and took several snapshots of the tanks in action, this being the first time that he has carried a camera in public.
