**PROHIBITION FORCES ARE
PREPARING FOR ACTION**

Pass Resolution at a Joint Meeting
to Express Sentiments

A joint conference of the Prohibition Union, the W.C.T.U. and the Norfolk County Ministerial Association was held in the Sunday school hall of the Baptist church, Simcoe, on Friday afternoon, April 20th, to discuss the situation which has arisen from a recent news despatch sent out from Port Dover to the daily press, which is contained in the resolution which follows:

WHEREAS it has come to our attention that liquor is being shipped by small boats from the port of Port Dover in the County of Norfolk and Province of Ontario,

AND WHEREAS it appears that such shipments of liquor are intended for entry into the United States of America,

AND WHEREAS the laws of the United States of America prohibit the importation of liquor,

AND WHEREAS the Government of Canada do not insist upon the production of documents showing such shipments to have entered any foreign country,

AND WHEREAS there is a treaty between the Dominion of Canada and the United States of America whereby the Government of the Dominion of Canada agree to assist the Government of the United States of America to prevent such shipments of liquor from entering the United States of America,

AND WHEREAS as shown by the following extract from the Simcoe Re-

former of April 12th, 1928, sufficient efforts are not being made by the Government of the Dominion of Canada to prevent shipments of liquor from the port of Port Dover,

"PORT DOVER RUM FLEET TO DEFEY THE U. S. CHASERS"

"International rum-runners are prepared to stage a bitter battle against the United States liquor-chasing staff, and a modern armored bullet-proof speed boat which resembles a submarine chaser has been launched in Port Dover harbor.

"A fleet of five rum-running boats is docked here, four having 'wintered' at the Port, while the fifth boat has recently been constructed.

"Revenue officials on the other side already have announced their intention of placing boats at two-mile intervals, equipped with machine guns,
