

Russia. A large majority of the stations in Russia are operated by local Soviets and labor unions, which are employing radio extensively in disseminating Communistic documents and education. The big 40,000-watt station at Moscow is owned by the government, while the 19,000-watt station at Leningrad is operated by a broadcasting company.

It is reported that passenger trains running between Moscow and Leningrad will be equipped soon with radio telephones.

The world has continued to increase its broadcasting facilities during the last few months until there are now 441 broadcasting stations in foreign countries. Europe has 202; North America, outside of the United States, 129; South America, fifty-two; Asia, twenty-two; Oceania, twenty-seven, and Africa, seven.
