

Growing Better Apples

Apple growers, whose trees suffer from "American blight," are now being advised to grow nasturtiums.

The large climbing variety are recommended, and they are allowed to run wild. Some growers start them under glass, and then plant them out round the base of the apple-trees sa soon as the frosts are over.

It is said that the results are amazing. Trees which have been white with blight shake it off and bear fine crops of healthy fruit.

The first year's results, however, may not be completely successful. In that case, the experiment should be continued the following year. Given a fair chance, the remedy seems to be successful every time.


